  Convenient sunfish launching/storage



#### Safety & Security is a priority

- Lighting Improvements Engineered light plan for improved safety and useability.
- Lockable gate required for transient slips
- Public access WebCam Surveillance (not just police cams)
- Police outpost
- No wake zone for approach to harbor
- EMS/AED/Police Locations (Backboard/Defibrillator etc)

# Harbor Master Position is key to ensuring stewardship of the waterfront investment

Full time position reporting to the Town Manager

- Autonomy and focus is critical to waterfront operations and infrastructure management
- Prioritize hospitality
- Position can be modeled after the successful Albemarle Plantation Resort Marina Organization
- Empowered to adjust policy to meet the dynamic needs of the waterfront



#### Seawall Improvements

- If the seawall can be retained a cap on top would increase accessibility and access to the boats and boaters when launching.
- Seawalls could also be improved with wood bumper areas to make it more user friendly and protect boats.

#### **Small Boat Launch Ramp**

- Launching over the seawall is challenging and can cause damage to the boats
- This would improve access for all boats and improve access for handicapped and other boaters

#### Floating Dock system to support local day use

- The Entrance & Life Safety Area (lifejacket storage, AED, spine boards, etc.) is level with the community dock.
- Walkway goes down to water-level docks / floating docks.
- Local boaters with smaller vessels could more easily access lower docks.


