

Northeastern Regional Airport (IATA: EDE, ICAO: KEDE, FAA LID: EDE) is a public use airport in Chowan County. It is owned by the Town of Edenton and located three nautical miles (6 km) southeast of downtown. The airport is categorized as a general aviation facility. The Airport Manager, Harry Davis, oversees the day-to-day operations while also working with an Airport Commission board. The airport is staffed by part-time employees.

The airport was first built by the U.S. Navy during World War II as Marine Corps Air Station Edenton, before becoming Naval Auxiliary Air Station Edenton, before becoming a civilian airport. Many of the old military buildings on the property now serve civilian or commercial purposes.

New Hangar Project
